"To be able to register in the second year and continue his/her study in the institute at the end of the first year a student must

i. Complete satisfactorily at least minimum 60 credits for B. Tech Program

AND

ii. Obtain a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not lower than 4.00."

6.Adding & Dropping courses under Clause 9.6: Against Clause 9.6(i) the Senate recommended replacement of the last sentence by However, student is permitted to get registered for only one dropped course, debarred course, incomplete subject along with the regular courses offered in the running semester.
