Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Merit Scholarship For 100 Students Belonging To Scheduled Caste Securing Admissions For Higher Education In Institutes Of National Importance— Year 2019-20

Social Justice and Special Assistance department of Government of Maharashtra is inviting applications under Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Merit Scholarship for students of Scheduled Caste/Neo-Buddhist securing admissions for Higher Education in Institutes of National Importance of India for the Academic Year 2019-20.

Eligibility Criteria for Applicants

- Applicant should belong to Scheduled Caste/ Neo-Buddhist category Applicant must be a domicile of State of Maharashtra
- Family income of Applicant from all the sources should not exceed Rs 6.00 Lakh for the last year
- Upper age limit for Graduate Courses is 25 Years and for Post Graduate Course is 30 Years
- Applicant should be studying in first year of respective course. Applications of other applicants not studying in first year would be considered only if enough applications are not received.
- Applicant should have passed class XII examinations from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education or equivalent examination from other boards in the State of Maharashtra
- For Graduate Courses, applicant must have passed class XII examination with minimum 55% (For Direct S.Y. admissions, applicant must have passed Diploma with minimum 55%)
- This scholarship is applicable only for courses in approved Institutes of National Level. List of such institutes is available in Annexure 'B' of detailed advertisement
- Students will be bound by all the rules and regulations issued from time to time under said scholarship from Government of Maharashtra
- Government will be the final authority to sanction the scholarship under this scheme
- Selected applicants will not be eligible to take benefit of Government of India Scholarship

Benefits Under Scheme

- All the Tuition Fees, Exam Fees, Registration Fees, Gym membership Fees, Library Fees, Computer fees etc. decided by the Institutes will be sanctioned
- Hostel and Mess expenses as charged by the Institute will be sanctioned
- If applicant does not get admission in hostel due to unavailability of the seats, then hostel and mess expenses reimbursed on the basis of expenses charged by the institutes.
- Applicants not residing in the respective hostel will be given Maintenance Allowance as per the Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship.
- A total of Rs. 10000/- (Rs. 5000/- for Books and Rs. 5000/- for other educational expenses) will be provided per annum.
