

Training Program on REMOTE SENSING AND GEOSPATIAL TECHNOLOGY FOR LANDSLIDE MITIGATION AND MANAGEMENT IN NORTH EASTERN REGION from 24/07/2022 to 28/07/2022

The Department of Civil Engineering, NIT Mizoram in Collaboration with IIT Tirupati Navavishkar I-Hub Foundation (IITTNiF) Technology Innovation Hub in Positioning and Precision Technologies organized a five- day training program on 'Remote Sensing and Geospatial Technology for Landslide Mitigation and Management in North Eastern Region' from 24/07/2022 to 28/07/2022. The main objectives were to acquaint participants with varied applications of space technology in disaster risk reduction, to learn and demonstrate the use of space technology applications for landslide monitoring, mapping and management, and to familiarize with space technology application in assessment and monitoring of hazards and update participants with recent advancement in space technology and its usage in north eastern region. **Prof. (Dr.) K. N. Satyanarayana, Director, IIT Tirupati** was the Chief Guest for the training

program. About 43 participants from north eastern Indian viz. States Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, and Tripura, had attended the said training. The government officials



were nominated from GSI, State Disaster Management Authority and PWD.




A five-day workshop on ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND HPC from 25/07/2022 to 29/07/2022
