

### RESEARCH OUTLOOK @ NIT MIZORAM

**K. Santha Ram**, a full-time research scholar in **English** working on Disability Studies at the Institute. His research focuses on analysing the disability representation in Hindu Mythology, Folklore and Bollywood. Disability studies is one of the emerging areas in the fields of systematic inquiry. Starting from ancient civilizations to the present, persons with disability are stigmatized and stereotyped. Through this research, the



conventional notions of disability would be contested. And the possible outcome of this research is to mobilize people about persons with a disability using Hindu mythology and Bollywood.
